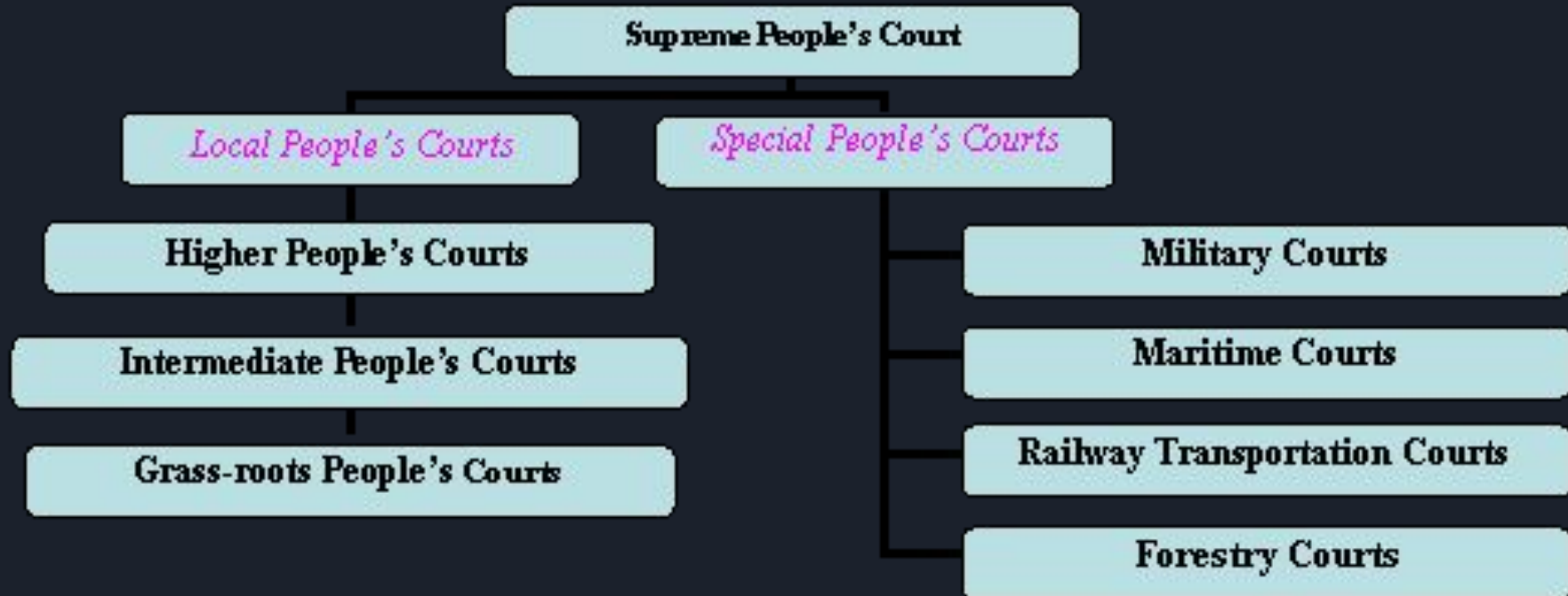


The Chinese Legal System

The Hierarchy of the Chinese Court System
